

## Der-Wörter im Überblick:

Der-Words are determiners that follow the pattern of the definite article. This means their ending will reflect both the **gender** and the **case** of the noun they determine:

For the **Nominative** case:

- **-er** ending for masculine nouns: dieser, jeder, welcher (same ending as **der**)
  - **dieser** Weg, **dieser** Augenblick
- **-e** ending for feminine nouns: diese, jede, welche (same ending as **die**)
  - **diese** Straße, **diese** Tür
- **-es** ending for neuter nouns: dieses, jedes, welches (same ending as **das**)
  - **dieses** Lied, **dieses** Leben

For the **Accusative** case:

- **-en** ending for masculine nouns: diesen, jeden, welchen (same ending as **den**)
  - **diesen** Weg, **diesen** Augenblick
- Other genders stay the same, just like their definite articles.
